1. Use the website <https://www.iknowit.com/> to practice math. I have set up an account for individual students with 2 assigned lessons. The lesson is an extension of the fractions introduction from last week. The lessons are “Fractions of Shapes” and “Multiplication to 10”. To log on:

Click the blue “login” button. The class code is 4Hosford .

The username is your first name and the password is 4Hosford. It will take you to your assignments. You can also try anything else that is on the page.

2. Use the RazKids website again for a new reading assignment.

3. Use the sentence “I like spring” to add interesting word choices and make the sentence longer. Do this several times to see how interesting you can make the sentence. Ex.: I like spring.

I really enjoy spring.

I really enjoy jumping in puddles in the spring.

I absolutely love splashing in puddles in the spring.

4. Read every day for at least 30 minutes.

5. Using a book you have read, think of a different way the story could have ended. Write a paragraph that describes what could have happened and what the consequences would have been.
