Choose at least one activity/environmental action that interests you, create a plan (about how you and your family can accomplish this activity), introduce the plan to your family and discuss "How" you can make this plan work as a group.

How to document this Environmental Action:

- 1. Do the research and watch the videos.
- 2. Choose an activity (Your choice! What could you do?)
- 3. Jot down your plan. (How will you do this activity? point form of ideas to discuss with your family)
- 4. Present your ideas. Choose **how you would like to share** the Environmental Action chosen. This could be a written essay, a poster, a power point presentation, a video, a picture, an Art project, a song, a poem...(your choice).
- 5. No due date! Work at your own pace! Have fun! I would love to hear about and/or see your ideas!
