1. Read for at least 30 minutes every day. This can be a picture book, chapter book that you are working on, newspaper, magazine, video game instructions, etc. Anything that you find interesting.
2. Practice Math multiplication facts on the website <https://www.multiplication.com/games/all-games> .
3. Write 5 questions you would ask your favourite character from a book, movie, or TV show. What would you like to know about them? What do you think their answers would be? Share this with someone (parent, sibling, pet).
4. Use the website <https://www.raz-kids.com/> to read the assigned reading and answer the questions. You can log in at the kids login button. Your username is your first name and the password is King4 .
5. PLAY! Put down your electronics for at least 30 minutes each day and just play. Play outside, in your room, with your toys, with a sibling, a game of cards, a board game, etc.
