Write another sentence about what you dislike about staying home. Write a third sentence about which one you prefer. *Make a list of fun things to do outside. | Have your child use capitals, spacing, periods and details. <br> Each completed writing should consist of at least three sentences. <br> Encourage your child to sound out the words they are spelling. Common words (the, is, you, and) should be spelled correctly. |
